

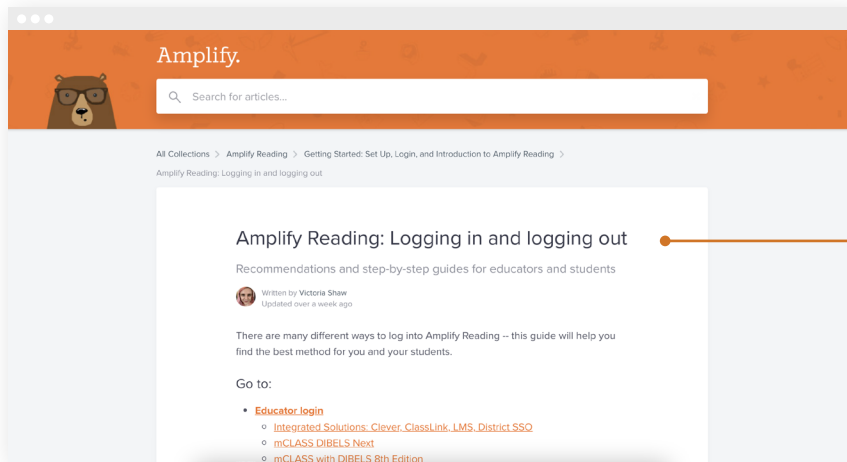

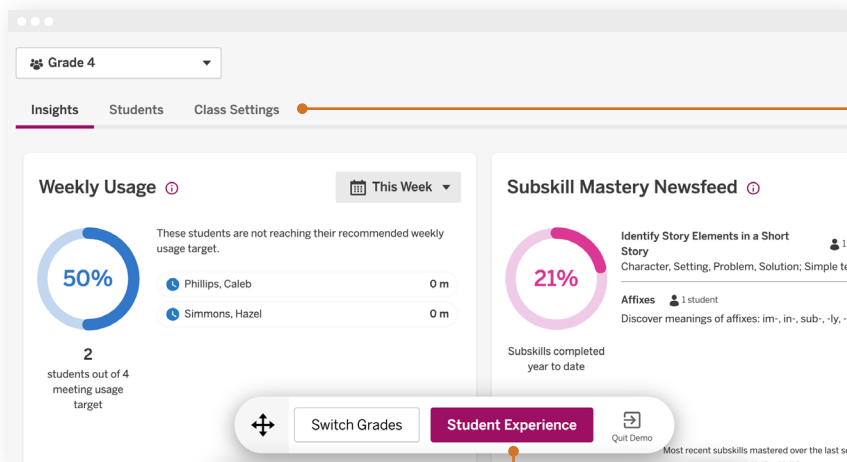


Amplify Reading 101

Use this checklist as a refresher on what we covered in the session to help you implement Amplify Reading in your classroom.



1. Make sure you know how you and your students will **log into your accounts**. If needed, confirm your login method with your administrator.

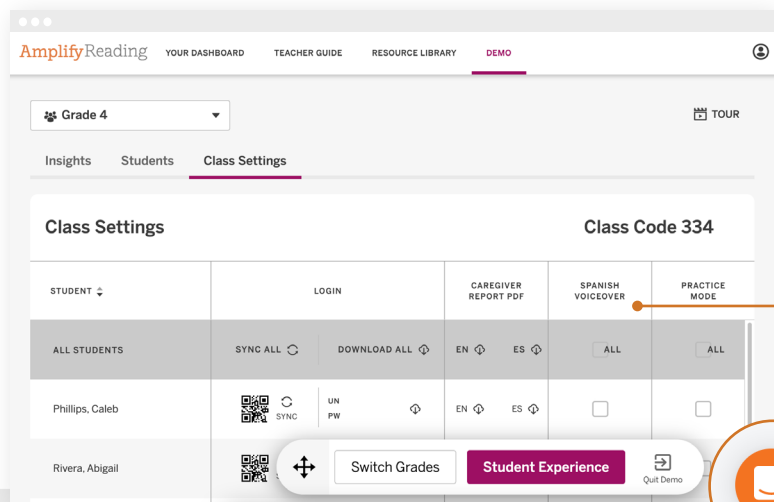


2. Prepare your students' login credentials by either:

- Logging into your Amplify Reading teacher account and **downloading the login information** from the **Class Settings** tab, or
- Ensuring your students know how to use your **third-party login solution** (Clever, Classlink, Google).



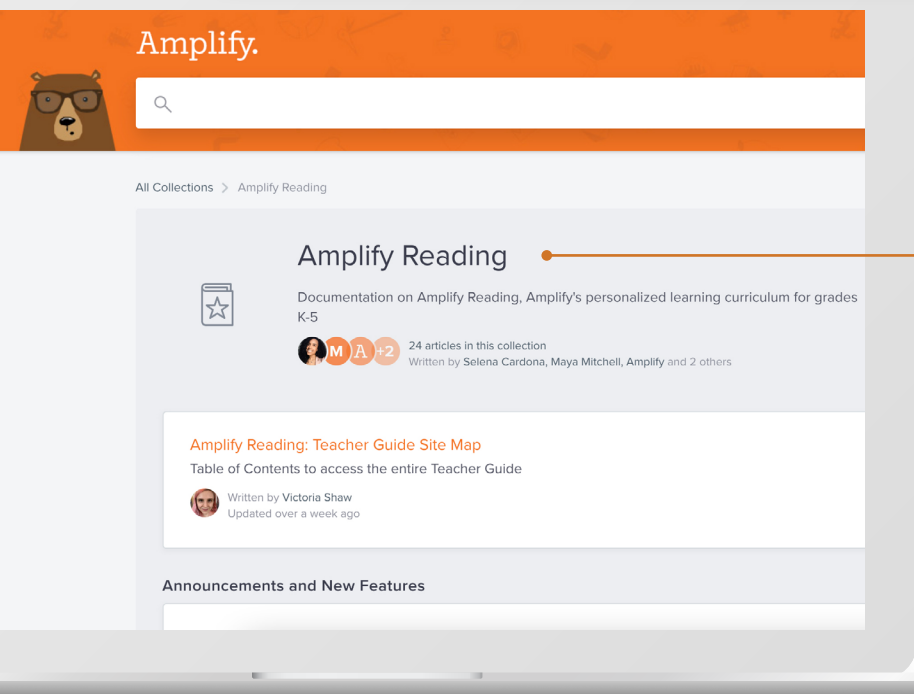
3. Open the **Demo Tool** and access the **Student Experience** in the grade level you teach. Play at least two skill games. Unsure of which game to begin with? Check out the **multiple games** and skill domains they cover.



4. Locate the **Spanish voiceover** feature in the **Class Settings** tab, and enable it for any of your students who require it or may benefit from it.



If you need help, just click on the **Amplify Chat** icon in the bottom right-hand corner of your screen.



5. Visit the **Teacher Guide** from the top navigation bar of your **Teacher Dashboard**, and review Amplify Reading's robust library of help articles. We recommend beginning by scrolling to the article titled "**Welcome to Amplify Reading.**"
